CHAPTER 1

Installation

Angry Libs can be installed from PyPI:

```
$ pip install angrylibs
```

1.1 Updating

Updating Angry Libs is just as easy! You can get the latest version with this command:

```
$ pip install --upgrade angrylibs
```


CHAPTER 2

Usage

Once installed, you can use the `angrylibs` command.

Hint: You can also use the `libs` command for short!

To get started, just run the command by itself. You'll need to be connected to the Internet the first time you run the program.

```
$ angrylibs
```

The program will guide you through what you need to know the first time around, but if you'd ever like to see the instructions again, just reset your settings.

2.1 Resetting the Program

Just run the program with the `--reset-settings` flag to reset your Angry Libs settings.

```
$ angrylibs --reset
Are you sure you want to reset all Angry Libs settings [y/n] (n)? y
Success!
```

Now, just run the program again without the flag and it'll be just like new.
